

RANGE RULES

Keep the muzzle pointed down range at all times.

Keep your finger off the trigger except when shooting.

Keep the action open and the firearm unloaded, except when shooting. This is a “cold range” which means your gun is loaded at the firing line only.

When leaving the firing line temporarily, lay the unloaded firearm on the firing line shelf with the action open and the muzzle pointing down range. Any equipment is left at the owner’s risk.

Loaded firearms are not permitted to be handed from one person to another. Do not change lanes with a loaded firearm.

No one is allowed forward of the firing line.

Only fire at your target. No rapid firing, or drawing from a holster.

In the event of a jammed or malfunctioning firearm, lay the firearm on the tray, muzzle pointing down range and raise your hand for assistance from the RSO.

When you are finished shooting, keep the action open and place the unloaded firearm in your bin. Proceed to the range check-out area.

Persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. This adult must remain with the minor at all times.

A person without a pistol permit may shoot with a permitted person provided a range waiver is signed and the RSO determines that the guest understands basic pistol safety, and demonstrates safe technique while handling and shooting a firearm.

No food or drink is allowed in the range.

No targets are allowed closer than 25 feet.

Only ammunition purchased on site at Hoffman’s Gun Center will be used in the range.

Ear and eye protection must be put on BEFORE entering the range.

Spectators can view from the lobby area, they are not allowed in the range.
